Why include corporate/business memberships?

NACRC recognizes that it is desirable and necessary to interact with private enterprise. Since most members need and utilize corporate contact for technological and procedural advancements, through consulting, purchases, or informational inquiries, having associate members in the private sector is a benefit. NACRC feels that it becomes a more representative network when corporate memberships are included. We welcome any business or organization that will compliment the activities and objectives of the members of NACRC, to apply for membership.

What are the benefits to your business?

NACRC realizes the need for personal communication and networking between private enterprise and county officials on a national scale. Through this enhanced contact, both parties are able to better communicate their ideas and concerns. Through participation in a politically active association, corporate members can be kept informed of pertinent legislation. Finally, by being included in our annual membership directory, corporate members are introduced to county officials throughout the nation.

County Officials

NACRC provides members with educational opportunities specifically tailored to the needs of county information/records managers, recorders, registers of deeds, court clerks, election officials, archivists and other similar offices. These workshops or "certification programs" are held at national conferences and intended to increase the knowledge, efficiency, and effectiveness of members. NACRC publishes a quarterly newsletter and special bulletins to inform its members of NACRC activities, educational opportunities and legislative activity.

Additional Benefits

NACRC Membership Directory

Annually, NACRC publishes a membership directory which is distributed free of charge to each of its members as a resource and networking tool.

NACRC provides the opportunity to advertise in the Membership directory for a fee. The articles or any artwork must be provided to NACRC camera ready.

NACRC Newsletters & Bulletins

The "NACRC Bulletin" is a newsletter published quarterly and mailed to all members. Additional bulletins covering various issues are mailed to members as needed. The NACRC eNewsletter is distributed to members monthly.

All members, including corporate members, are invited to submit articles of interest for inclusion in the newsletters.

NACRC Listserv

The NACRC listserv is a valuable tool that allows for the immediate email distribution of questions and answers to members in a threaded discussion. This is very effective when immediate answers or action is needed for legislative and other issues that are extremely time sensitive. Members are able to share their issues and experience in real time and receive input from all over the country. All responses are saved and available as a research tool on the NACRC Web site.

Webinars & Seminar Video Replay

The NACRC Webinar is an internet based program that allows interactive educational seminars via teleconferencing and the internet.

We also video tape some of our educational sessions at the Legislative and Annual conference for replay to members via the NACRC Web site and on DVD.

Certified Public Official Program

Established in 1987 by NACRC and a leading University, the certified public official program, (CPO) allows members to obtain continuing education credits for attending NACRC sponsored seminars as well as other professionally recognized educational seminars. These earned credits can then be applied towards becoming nationally certified in Court Administration/Clerks to Boards, Land Records Administration, Records Management and Election Administration.

Scholarship Program

Established in 2007 with participation from our corporate/business members, a minimum of two scholarships are offered each year that include paid travel and registrations at the legislative and annual conference. These scholarships are directed towards long time members that through budget constraints are unable to attend a conference. NACRC (Database) Membership

NACRC has approximately 600 members. NACRC is a dynamic organization comprised of key county officials, deputies, managers, and other similar officials, with a rapidly growing membership.

NACRC Dues Policy

Dues are normally payable on August 1 of each year, however rejoining member payment will not be considered in arrears until after August 31.

Dues may be paid by check or credit card (Visa, Mastercard, American Express).

Each membership is entitled to all benefits that NACRC offers for that level.

- Current members' dues are payable on or before **August 1** of the year covered by the dues. Notice will be *given* to any member that has not paid by August 31. If dues remain unpaid within two weeks from the end of **September**, the non-paying member will be removed from member list and benefits will cease. Membership dues for delinquent members will be paid at the normal annual rate upon reinstatement to membership.
- Once a delinquent member is removed from the list, no member benefits will be available until reinstatement to good standing.
- Only members in good standing (paid dues) and in the membership levels indicated below will be eligible to vote in that year's elections.

- Replacements may be made within a membership **category** (*replacements*) – if someone retires, their membership can be moved to the new person in the position, etc.
- Dues are not prorated and are non-refundable.
